## Allegheny County Camp Cadet

Established in 2004, Allegheny County Camp Cadet is a youth camp open to boys and girls ages 12 to 14.

The camp is designed to help young individuals gain a better understanding of law enforcement and other community agencies in Allegheny County.

This weeklong experience takes place at Camp Guyasuta in Sharpsburg, just outside of Pittsburgh, where cadets immerse themselves in a structured and engaging program.

Camp Cadet is fully funded by contributions and operates as a nonprofit organization, ensuring that there is no cost for cadets to participate.



## What to expect at camp.

During their time at camp, cadets will participate in a variety of activities designed to build self-esteem, self-discipline, and lasting friendships.

Throughout the week, cadets will engage in hands-on experiences such as investigating a mock crime scene and participating in a mock trial. They will also witness live demonstrations by specialized units, including SWAT/SERT and the Bomb Squad. Each morning will begin with physical training and a morning run, instilling discipline and teamwork.

Additionally, cadets will be introduced to Military Courtesy as part of their structured learning experience. In the evenings, they will have the opportunity to unwind with recreational activities such as basketball and volleyball competitions.

The camp will begin on Sunday, August 3, 2025, and will conclude with a graduation ceremony on Saturday, August 9, 2025.



## How do you get there?

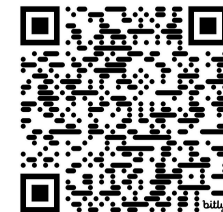
Interested boys and girls must **submit their application no later than April 18, 2025.**
